It's hard to imagine what Shabbat would be like in our community without our Eruv. Whether it is pushing a stroller to shul or to a friend's home, assisting a wheelchair-bound congregant to attend shul, carrying a Tallit bag or house key or sefer, the Eruv significantly impacts every one of us every Shabbat of the year.

Our Eruv requires a detailed, weekly inspection followed by timely repairs. Our employees spend 6-7 hours/week analyzing every pole attachment, twine, and fence that comprise the 26+ mile boundary. Over 1,000 items are reviewed each week, all while navigating traffic along with whatever weather our New England climate presents to us.
